## **CUFOS Buggy Policy**

This applies to all groups with children who are brought to CUFOS in buggies or strollers. Please note that fire regulations prohibit having obstructions in the hallway; hence the need for this policy.

- (1) Buggies must *not* be brought into the building through the front doors. All buggies and strollers must enter by the side gate into the playground.
- (2) Buggies or strollers must *not* be brought into the building for the purpose of taking children out of their strollers, or to put them back in; this should be done in the playground and the children then brought into the building by the side entrance, so as to not cause any obstruction in the hallway.
- (3) If absolutely necessary, a maximum of four buggies or strollers may be left in the Cufos hallway *only if they are collapsed* and can be placed in such a way as to not cause obstruction to the fire exit.
- (4) Non-collapsible buggies must be left outside in the playground, *but not if the Hilltop preschool is in session*. In such cases, parents or carers leaving children at the building but not staying *must* take buggies away with them.
- (5) If buggies are left in the playground, parents or carers must make their own arrangements for securing them and protecting them against the weather. CUFOS is not responsible for the safety of buggies or strollers that are left in the playground, nor for their contents.
- (6) If buggies or strollers are brought into the building and marks and dirt are left on the floor as a result, the CUFOS user group key holder is responsible for cleaning the floor before leaving the building.
- (7) The CUFOS user group key holder is responsible for seeing that this policy is adhered to at all times and ensuring parents and carers know about it. If a CUFOS trustee or committee member finds the hallway cluttered with open buggies, a formal warning will be issued to the user group.
